THE CAMPAIGN TO NOWHERE BY Terry Epton


With Democratic primary lattles raging and the presidential election a few months away, radicals are asking themselves: "So what?" It is a good question, because anti-authoritarians invarially reject electoral politics. All of the candidates, both mainstream and third party, represent shadings of the status quo. Anyone who would be president is dangerous.

However, some candidates are more dangerous than others. In evaluating different presidential aspirants, it is necessary to be clear on what we want from our political leaders. The most essential quality is that they be easy to hate.

America's president is the living symbol of our enemy, the State. We need someone to focus our scorn, distrust, and abuse on. From this perspective, the best recent presidents have been Lyndon Johnson and Richard Nixon. Both were ugly, inept, and tangibly evil. Each did as much to disrupt and discredit government authority as the generations of radicals who struggled against them.

Inoffensive, mild presidents like Gerald Ford and Jimmy Carter were frustrating disappointments. Despite their persistant bungling, it was impossible to get really worked up over them. They were good for a chuckle or yawn, at best.

From a disruptionist standpoint, by far our worst recent
president was John Kennedy.
His style, youth, and good looks
charmed most of the nation. He
could assasinate foreign heads
of state, lay the groundwork
for the Vietnam War, and wiretap Martin Luther King without



suksequently tarnishing his progressive image. The Bay of Pigs and the Culan Missle Crises would have provoked furious demonstrations under LBJ, but Kennedy was able to pull both off with barely a murmer of opposition.

Ronald Reagan is widely considered to be the central threat in 1984. However, the politician with the greatest potential for inspiring trust and confidence in government is Gary Hart. His Kennedy-esque image and youthful good looks will make it nearly impossible to get millions into the streets, cursing his name.

Either Ronald Reagan on Walter Mondale would make ideal targets for the radical opposition. Single-handedly, Reagan has already re-ignited the peace movement and re-invigorated environmentalism. Half the country despises him and every-

thing he stands for. Walter Mondale would be almost as good. His shrill style, hooded eyes, and reputation as a lackey of special interests make him easy to loathe. With very little effort, Fritz could become the LBJ of the 1980's.

In the early 1930's, when Adolph Hitler was on the verge of assuming power, the German Communist Party muted their opposition to him. Believing a Hitler victory would alienate the progressive masses, the German CP reasoned that a brief Nazi incumbercy would touch off a people's revolution. The trgic consequences of this miscalculation have made later generations of radicals wary of similar strategies.

Is Ronald Reagan a potential Hitler? Does the increased danger of nuclear war under Reagan require us to support any liberal who runs against

were that simple. But unfontunately, all the mainstream candidates are committed to American military hegemony. - In November 1983 Congress approved a Reagan budget request funding "training to law enforcement officials of friendly countries on combating terrorism." This Anti-Terrorism Assistance Program is similar to the Agency for International Development's former Office of Public Safety Program (OPS). Congress had closed down the OPS in 1974 after learning that students were trained in torture techniques and bombmaking.
- Under 1983 revised guidelines, the FBI has authority to spy on legal organizations and to infiltrate political groups "in a manner that may influence the exercise of rights protected by the first amendment."
- Domestically, the administration has used the specter of terrorism to give greater power
- to police and intelligence agencies.

 It has given the CIA legal authority to conduct domestic operations.

'Land of the free'

The spirit of Sen. Joseph McCarthy is still chilling free speech in the U.S.

The Reagan administration has repeatedly invoked the McCarran-Walter Act, passed in 1952 at the height of the McCarthyite anticommunist hysteria, to prevent foreign communists, other leftists and progressives from expressing their views in the U.S.

Most recently, Guillermo Ungo, president of the Democratic Revolutionary Front (FDR) of El Salvador, had his visa invalidated in March. Earlier, Hector O'Queli, an international representative of the FDR was denied permission to enter the U.S. to take part in a forum on the Salvadoran elections. Anamargarita Gasteazorro, a leader of the youth group of one of the moderate organizations in the FDR was not granted a visa to participate in a tour of international student leaders sponsored by Democratic Socialists of America.

Others who have not made it past the Statue of Liberty since Ronald Reagan took office include Nobel Prize winner Gabriel Garcia Márquez; Tomas Borge, Nicaragua's minister of the interior; the late writer Julio Cortazar; Italian playwright Dario Fo; and Hortensia de Allende, widow of Salvador Allende. Nino Pasti, a re tired Italian general who was a member of the NATO Military Committee stationed at the Pentagon from 1963

through 1966, was denied entry after he became a vocal opponent of the decision to place cruise and Pershing 2 missiles in Europe

Even the State Department concedes that these people Even the State Department concedes that these people aren't out to promote political violence and terrorism in the U.S. Speaking of the denial of entry to Dario Fo, a State Department official said, "Nobody in State thinks that Fo is going to foment revolution or throw bombs. It's just that Fo's record of performance with regard to the U.S. is not good. Dario Fo has never had a good word to say about [the U.S.]." In other words, it's their ideas not their actions that the U.S. ideas, not their actions that the U.S. government is afraid

The "ideological exclusion" provisions of the McCarran-Walter Act are so broad and sweeping that they declare foreigners ineligible to receive visas, for example, whenever a consular officer or the attorney general "has reason to believe" that the person seeks entry "to engage in activities which would be prejudicial to the public interest." The result is that people in the "land of the free" are not free to hear dissenting views from abroad.

This archaic and antidemocratic ghost should be exorcised once and for all.




